

NURSERY REOPENING

We are excited to welcome our children back to the nursery during the 10:30 am service, but please realize things will be a little different. We are making changes to keep our children and staff safe, healthy and happy. Here are a few reminders of some nursery policies and additions being implemented as we reopen:

Parents/guardians will be asked to sign in each Sunday. Additional information that may be helpful to the care of a child is appreciated.

ALL staff and children will have a temperature check with a no-touch thermometer upon arrival. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will be asked not to come inside the nursery.

A diaper Bag with diapers and change of clothes, formula, etc., should be labeled, and instructions given at drop-off.

Children will be spaced apart during snack time, and we will encourage children to stay apart during play time. However, social distancing at this age is hard.

Snacks of goldfish or animal crackers will be available along with apple juice or water. If your child has allergies, please let the nursery staff know.

Nursery workers will be required to wear masks and wash hands/sanitize frequently. Children will not be required to wear masks, but hand washing/sanitizing will be encouraged.

Toys: For the time being, all cloth toys and other hard-to-sanitize objects will be removed from the nursery.

In addition to weekly cleaning, all high touch surfaces in nursery (toys, light switches, door knobs, tables, chairs, changing table, play-sets, etc.) will be cleaned and disinfected after each service is over.

If a child or family member of a child that has been in the nursery has symptoms or tests positive to COVID, we ask that you contact the church office at 806-762-2893.
